UNREASONABLE BEHAVIOURS?

Actions that violate social or professional norms, often causing harm or inconvenience and reflecting a lack of respect.



HARASSMENT?

Harassment is unwelcome behavior causing discomfort, fear, or distress, often repetitive, targeting individuals through intimidation, threats, or inappropriate actions.



ABUSE?

Abuse is intentional harm or mistreatment which could be physical, emotional or verbal, often infringing on individual rights.

IF YOU ENCOUNTER UNREASONABLE BEHAVIOUR, HARASSMENT OR ABUSE...

1. Raise your concerns to School Leaders

- Your school leaders are empowered to manage the situation.

2. Contact STU

- Calling the STU is your right. STU Officers will guide you on the follow-up actions.

3. Contact the authorities

- If you feel that your safety has been compromised, you need not hesitate to contact the relevant authorities, including the police.
